A SPORTING CHANCE

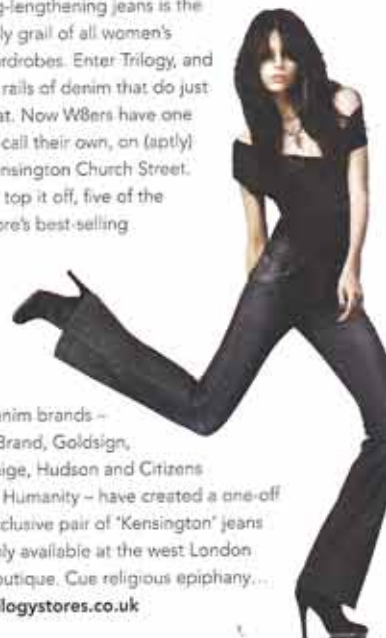
